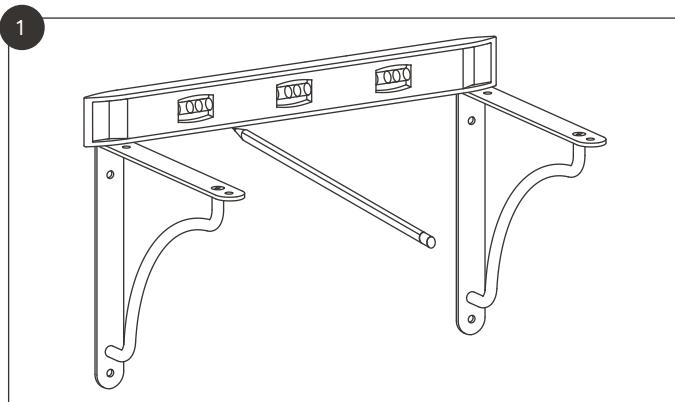
FITTING

Before fitting, choose a suitable shelf to be used with the shelf brackets, work out how many brackets are required and how they'll be spaced. If using a timber shelf, screw to the brackets using the 18mm screws. If using a stone shelf, secure with strong double-sided glazing tape or similar contact adhesive.

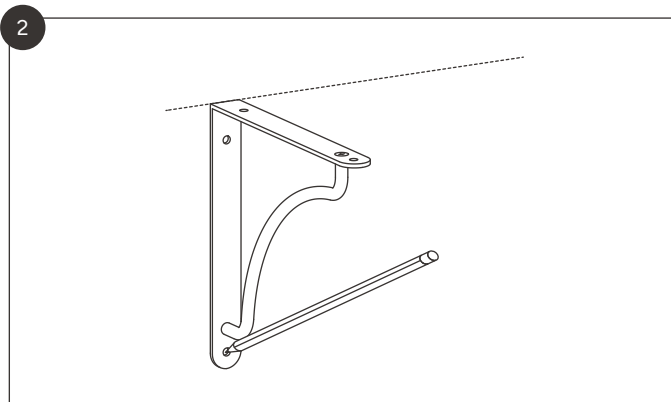
CARE

Use a mild detergent and a damp cloth to maintain the hardware, avoiding chemical cleaners. Touching the hardware with another metal or hard object is likely to scratch and/or damage it.

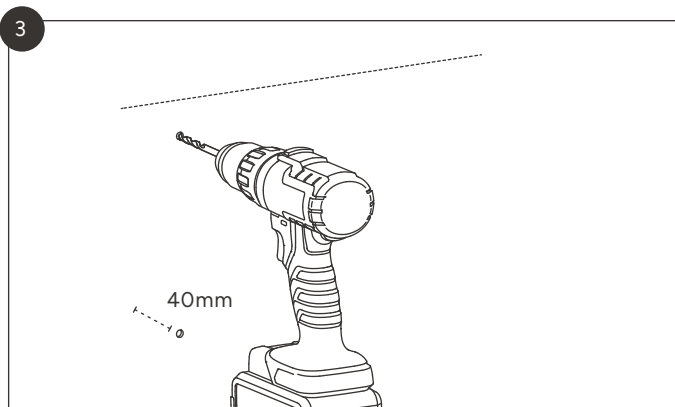
Shelf bracket instructions



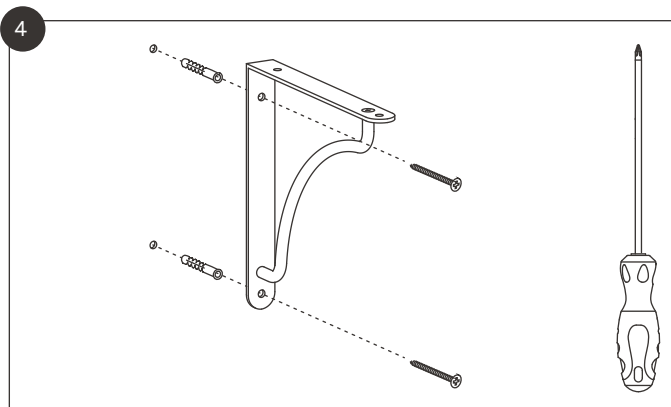
Mark the horizontal shelf position.



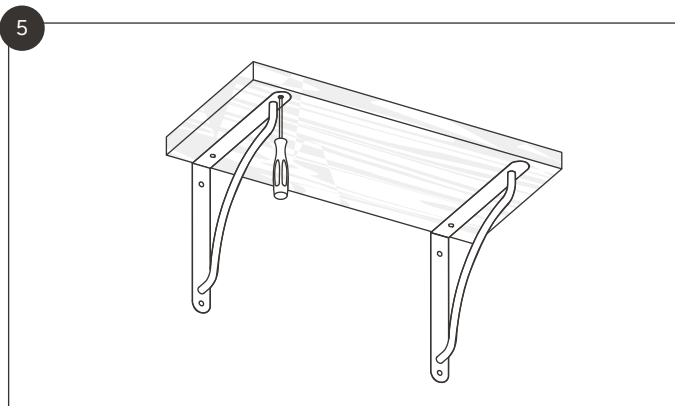
Use the shelf bracket to mark the vertical hole positions.



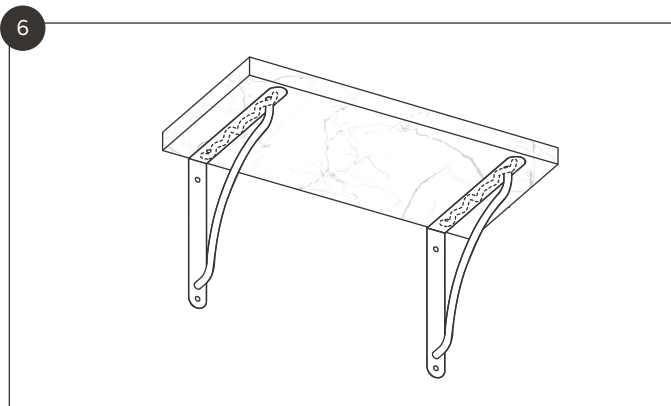
Drill pilot holes where marked, followed by 8mm holes, 40mm deep.



Insert wall plugs, then use the long screws to fix the bracket to the wall. **Use a long screwdriver to avoid damaging the bracket.**



Timber shelves: Use the 18mm screws provided.



Stone shelves: Use contact adhesive.
