The included trays help catch excess water runoff, keeping surrounding floors or surfaces clean and dry. Suitable for flowers, herbs, succulents, small shrubs, or tabletop planting, these planters are weather-resistant, lightweight yet durable, and easy to move, making them ideal for year-round use to enhance any space with a fresh, natural touch.

4. Safety Warnings & Important Notices

4.1 General Safety Warnings

Read all instructions carefully before use. This product is intended for plant cultivation and decorative purposes only; do not use for other purposes such as storing hazardous materials, serving as a seat, or a toy for children. Keep the pots and trays out of reach of small children and pets to avoid accidental tipping, falls, or ingestion of soil, plants, or small plastic parts. Do not use

the pots if they are cracked, broken, deformed, or have sharp edges, as this may cause injury or structural failure.

4.2 Usage Safety

Do not exceed the maximum soil and plant weight capacity (recommended max 12 kg per pot, distributed evenly). Place the pots on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping, especially in windy outdoor conditions. Avoid placing the pots on elevated surfaces such as balconies without railings to reduce the risk of falling and injury. Do not expose the pots to extreme weather conditions including heavy frost, extreme heat above 60° C, or direct prolonged sunlight to prevent plastic degradation, melting, or discoloration.

4.3 Environmental Safety

Do not dispose of the pots and trays in household waste; follow local plastic recycling regulations to minimize environmental impact. Avoid contact with sharp objects, corrosive chemicals, or open flames to prevent scratches, damage, or melting of the plastic surface. Keep the pots away from heat sources such as heaters or stoves to avoid fire risk.

5. Instructions for Use

5.1 Preparation Steps

Unpack the two pots and two trays, and inspect for any damage during transportation. Place a layer of drainage material such as pebbles, broken pottery, or gravel at the bottom of each pot to improve water drainage and prevent root rot. Place the trays underneath the pots to catch excess water. Fill the pots with suitable potting soil, leaving a 2 – 3 cm gap at the top to prevent overflow when watering.

5.2 Planting Steps

Gently remove the plant from its nursery pot and place it in the center of the planter. Add more soil around the root ball, pressing firmly to eliminate air pockets and ensure stable support. Water the plant thoroughly until water drains from the bottom of the pot into the tray. Place the pot in a suitable location based on the plant's light and environmental needs such as a sunny windowsill for herbs or a shaded balcony for shade-tolerant flowers.

5.3 Precautions

Ensure the pots have proper drainage; do not block the drainage holes. Water plants according to their specific needs, avoiding overwatering to prevent root rot and excessive water buildup in the trays. Clean the trays regularly to remove debris, algae, or mold to maintain hygiene and appearance. For winter storage in cold climates, empty the soil, dry the pots and trays completely, and store them in a dry, cool place to prevent frost damage.

6. Maintenance & Cleaning

6.1 Cleaning

Empty the soil and plants from the pots before cleaning. Wipe the surface of the pots and trays with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust, dirt, or pet hair. For stubborn stains or dirt buildup, use a soft, damp cloth with a small amount of mild detergent; avoid using abrasive cleaners, strong chemicals such as bleach or alcohol, or harsh scrubbers that may scratch or damage the black plastic surface and texture. Rinse the pots and trays thoroughly with clean water and dry them completely before reuse or storage.

6.2 Maintenance

Regularly inspect the pots and trays for cracks, deformation, discoloration, or damage; replace damaged items immediately to ensure safety and aesthetics. Avoid dragging the pots or trays

across rough surfaces to prevent scratches. Store the pots and trays in a dry, cool place when not in use, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to extend their lifespan. Do not stack heavy objects on top of the pots to avoid deformation or damage.
