

2-Pack Door Chain Lock – Black Security Door Chain for Inside Door
Premium Thickened Chain – Instruction Manual

Product Overview

This 2-pack door chain lock provides an added layer of security for interior doors. Mounted on the door frame, it allows limited opening for visual identification while preventing unauthorized entry. The premium thickened construction ensures durability and reliable performance.

Package Contents

2x Door chain lock assemblies (each includes chain plate and strike plate)

1x Mounting hardware set (screws)

Key Features

Security Function: Allows door to open slightly for viewing visitors while preventing forced entry

Premium Thickened Chain: Heavy-duty construction resists cutting and tampering

Black Finish: Modern appearance complements various door styles

Easy Installation: Simple mounting with included hardware

2-Pack Value: Two complete units for multiple doors

Installation Instructions

Select Location: Mount on interior side of door, approximately 5-6 inches above doorknob.

Position Chain Plate: Hold chain plate against door edge (not door frame). Mark screw holes.

Pre-Drill Holes: Drill pilot holes at marked positions on door edge.

Attach Chain Plate: Secure chain plate to door edge using provided screws. Ensure chain hangs freely.

Position Strike Plate: Close door and mark position on door frame where chain will engage strike plate. Ensure chain reaches comfortably.

Pre-Drill Frame Holes: Drill pilot holes in door frame at marked position.

Attach Strike Plate: Secure strike plate to door frame using provided screws.

Test Operation: Slide chain into strike plate slot. Door should open limited distance when engaged.

How to Use

To Engage: Close door and slide chain into strike plate slot until fully seated.

To Release: Slide chain out of slot to allow full door opening.

Visual Identification: Engage chain before opening door slightly to identify visitors.

Important Warnings

SECURITY AID ONLY: Door chain locks are supplemental security devices. Not a substitute for primary door lock.

Ensure screws penetrate door frame securely – for hollow frames, use longer screws or toggle bolts.

Do not rely on chain lock for overnight security when away from home.

Chain can be defeated with sufficient force – not for high-security applications.

Keep chain lubricated occasionally for smooth operation.

Children should be supervised near doors with chain locks.

Maintenance

Periodically check screws for tightness.

Clean with soft, dry cloth.

Apply light oil to chain if needed.
