- Use a clean, slightly dampened cloth to wipe the main monitor body.
- To clean the screen, turn it off unplug it and wait for it to cool completely, then wipe it with a dry micro-fibre cloth.
- Do not use cleaning alcohol, ammonia-based liquids or other harsh cleaners.
- This monitor is designed with ventilation holes on the back of the casing. Do not cover or block them.
- Do not insert any object or spray any liquid into the vents.
- Avoid placing the monitor near heaters, stoves, fireplaces or other sources of heat, as well as in rooms lacking adequate ventilation.
- Do not position the monitor in unsafe locations. If the monitor falls, it may be damaged and may injure nearby people.
- Unplug the monitor if it is not going to be used for an extended period.
- Do not place heavy objects on the monitor, its power cord or any connected cable.
- Do not open the rear panel of the monitor, as it contains a high-voltage current even when not plugged in.

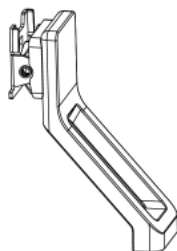


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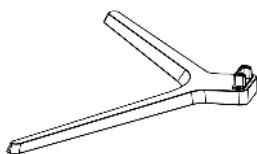

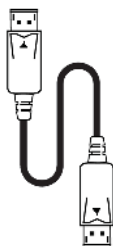

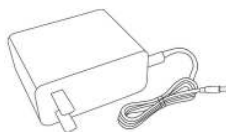

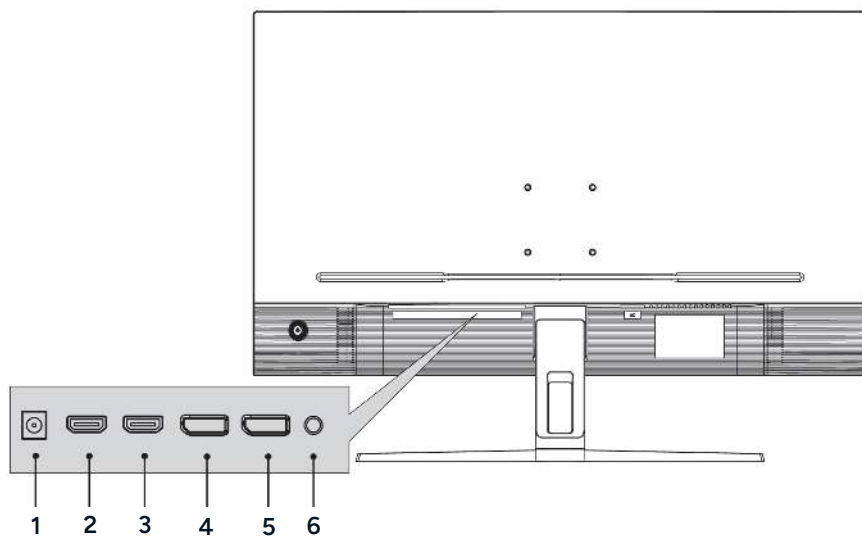
User Guide

Overview



1	Power Button	Button • Press and hold the for 3-5 seconds to turn the monitor on/off. • When the monitor is turned on, press to open the main menu. • Press to enter submenu. • Press to confirm menu adjustment and return to previous menu. Directional Stick Use to navigate the menus.

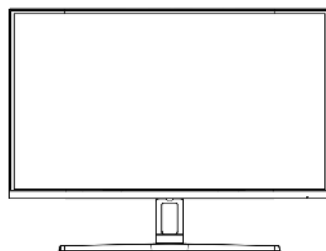
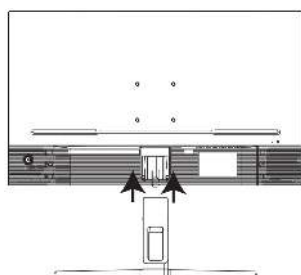
Assembly

WARNING: The panel of the monitor is fragile. Keep the foam underneath the monitor screen while assembling the stand.

1. Carefully remove the monitor, stand connector and stand base from the box.
2. Attach the stand base to the stand connector using the x2 M4x12mm Stand Screws.



3. Insert the connection block into the rear of the monitor and push down until it is securely in place.
4. Lift the monitor up straight and remove the lower foam. Stand the monitor up on the installed base.



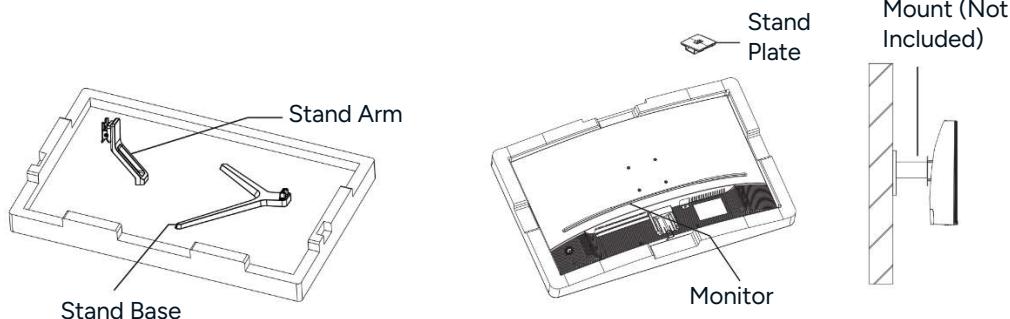
VESA Mount



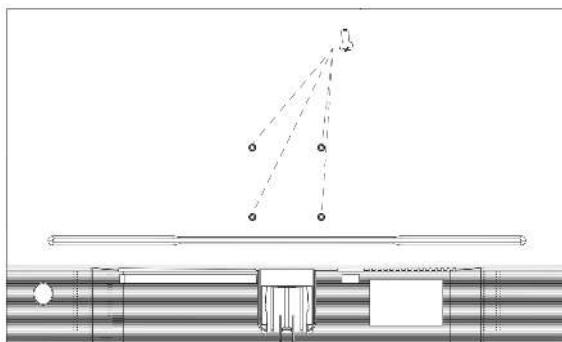
VESA mounting pattern 75x75mm, screw size M4.

Note: VESA mount and Mounting accessories are not included.

1. Open the box, remove the monitor with the protection foam attached and gently place it on a desktop or table. Remove the components and the foam covering the rear of the monitor.
2. Press the 'Release' button to remove the stand plate. If the monitor is already attached to the stand, remove the stand.



3. Assemble the mount according to the instructions provided with the mount.

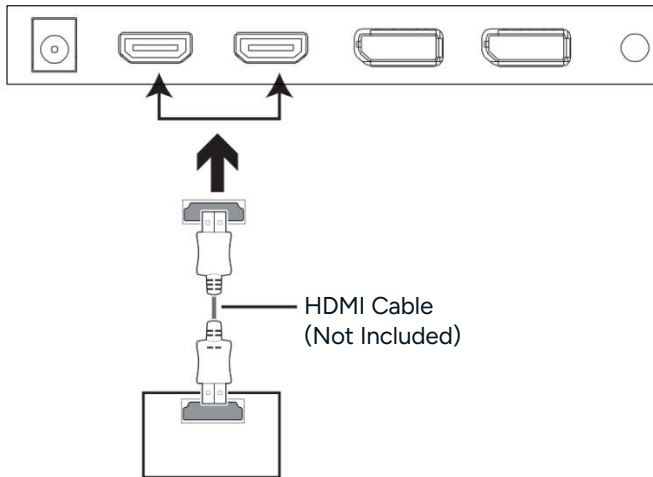
Step 1: Connect the Monitor to the Computer

Note:

Ensure the monitor is powered off before connecting any cables.

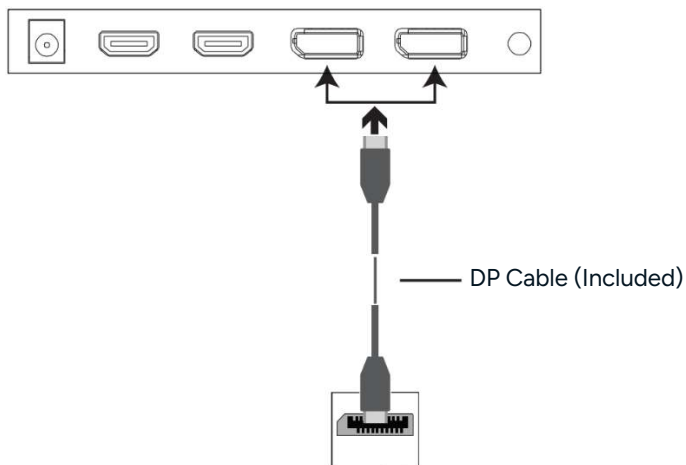
Option 1: HDMI Connection

1. Connect one end of an HDMI cable to the HDMI port on your computer.
2. Connect the other end to one of the HDMI ports on the monitor.



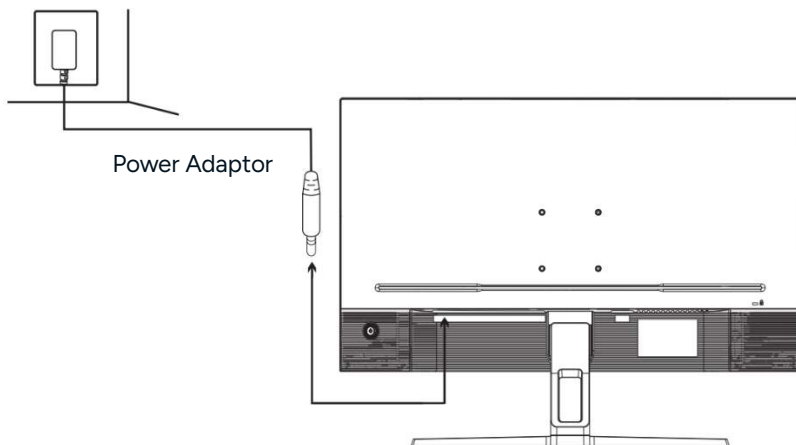
Option 2: DisplayPort Connection

1. Connect one end of the provided DP cable to the DP port on your computer.
2. Connect the other end to one of the DP ports on the monitor.



Step 2: Connect the Monitor to Power

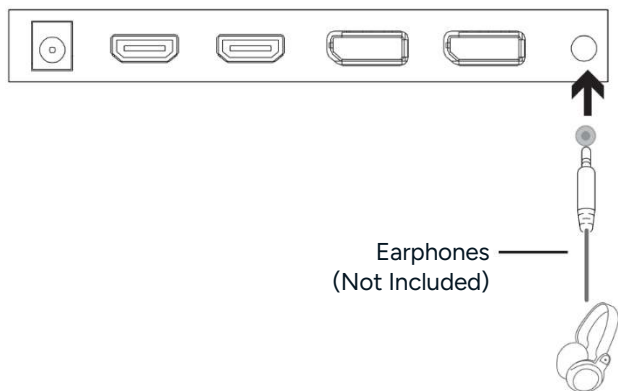
Connect the provided power adaptor to the monitor power input port, then connect the other end to an electrical outlet.



Step 3: Connect an External Audio Device (optional)

Earphones (Audio Out)

- Connect earphones, headphones, or external speakers (not provided) to the 3.5mm audio port on the monitor.
- If no sound is heard, ensure the monitor is selected as the default playback device in your computer's audio settings.



Operation

Powering On/Off

Press and hold the joystick for 3-5 seconds to turn the monitor on or off.

FreeSync

- To use this feature, ensure your hardware has FreeSync capability and the graphics drivers are fully up to date.
- After connecting, you may receive a prompt to enable the feature on your computer. If you do not receive the prompt, you may need to enable the function in your graphics card menu.
- See your graphics card manufacturer's documentation for instructions on how to turn on and/or enable FreeSync.

On Screen Display (OSD)

- The On-Screen Display (OSD) Menu may be used to adjust your monitor's settings and appears on the screen after turning on the monitor and pressing the 'Power' button.
- When using the monitor for the first time, it will configure optimal settings automatically.

Note:

The OSD is updated on an ongoing basis. Descriptions of some functions may vary slightly. Refer to actual operation for the final effect.

Using the OSD Menu

- 1. Press the joystick to open the On-Screen Display (OSD) menu.
- 2. Move the joystick up, down, left, or right to navigate through the menu options.
- 3. Press the joystick to select or adjust a highlighted setting.
- 4. After adjusting, press the joystick again to save changes and return to the previous menu.

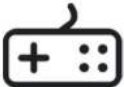
