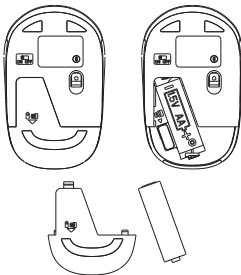
INSTALLING BATTERIES

1 Open the back cover

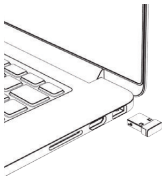
2 Insert the batterie as shown inside the batterie compartment

3 Close the back cover

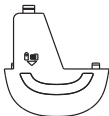


CONNECTING THE RECEIVER
