
**A Quick Look**


**Charging**



1. Insert the USB-C end of the included charging cable into the charging port on the bottom of the charging case.




2. Insert the charging cable's USB plug into the USB port of a computer or suitable USB charging adapter.




3. When placed inside the charging case, the earbuds will charge.


Power Button


Paired  
Slow Flashing LED

1. Press the charging case's power button to turn on the earbuds, then take the earbuds out of the charging case.
2. It will take 2-5 seconds for your earbuds to pair together. When paired, one earbud's LED indicator will flash blue and the other will flash red and blue alternately.
3. Go into the Settings app and into the Bluetooth page. Make sure Bluetooth is turned On before connecting to 'TWS Earbuds'.
4. Both earbud's LED indicator will slowly flash blue when paired to your phone.


**Earbud Controls**




1. Tap the left earbud's Multi-function button twice to lower volume.



2. Tap the right earbud's Multi-function button twice to raise volume.



3. Tap the left earbud's Multi-function button three times to go to the next song



4. Tap the right earbud's Multi-function button three times to go to the Previous song

## Earbud Controls (Continued)



1. Press and hold either earbud's Multi-function button for 1.5 seconds activate or deactivate Siri or Google Assistant.



2. Press either earbud's Multi-function button to answer and end a phone call.
